Location:

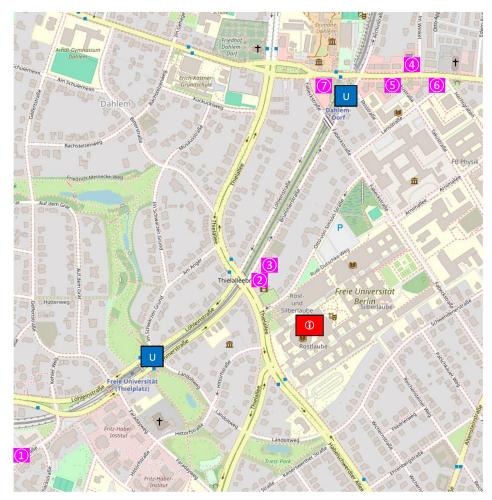
The conference will take place at the Freie Universität Berlin, Rost- und Silberlaube, Habelschwerdter Allee 45, 14195 Berlin

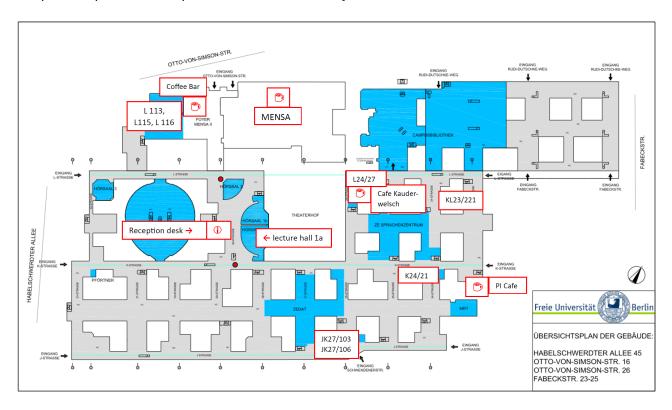

Main Building Map

Information for Presenters and Session Chairs

To ensure smooth sessions and presentations, please note the following guidelines:

Program & rooms: Please check the **conference program** (https://www.conftool.net/fgme2025/sessions.php) to find your session, room, and (if applicable) poster number.

Presentations: Bring your slides on a USB stick and upload them to the computer in your session room at least 10 minutes before the start of the session.

Posters: Posters are numbered as shown in the program. Please place yours on the wall stand (Posterständer) according to your assigned number.

Session chairs: Each session has an assigned chair (see program) who is responsible for keeping time. To help manage presentations, you will find 3-min, 1-min, and 0-min cards in each room. Chairs are asked to ensure fair time distribution and leave room for audience questions.

Timing & testing: Presenters are asked to be punctual and to test their presentations in advance. Each room is equipped with a notebook (with PowerPoint and a PDF reader). You are encouraged to use these, but if you prefer your own laptop, please bring the necessary adapters and check the setup ahead of time. All breaks can be used for testing equipment.

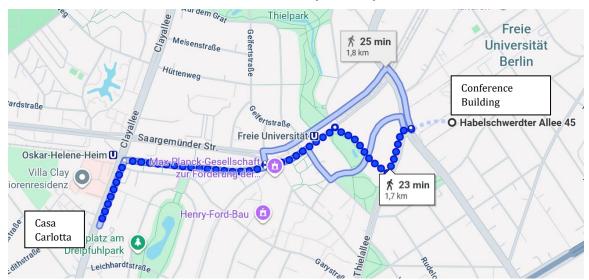

Eating Lunch with mensr:: CHEAT SHEET

Tutorial for Your Lunch at the Canteen

Try out our canteen!

The canteen at the venue ("Mensa") offers a wide range of food and drinks.

During weekdays, lunch is served between 11:00 am and 2:30 pm. However, some snacks are usually still available until 5:00 pm.

There are some other options near the conference venue, but not many.

Bring cash to use your MensaCard!

At the canteen, you can only pay using a special MensaCard that you will receive at the conference registration desk.

You need cash to top up your MensaCard (the cashless alternative involves a subscription and a complex registration process). There is an ATM just in front of the canteen.

Top up your MensaCard before lunch hours to avoid long queues.

To top up, **first insert** a banknote into one of the top-up machines, **then present** your MensaCard to the machine and **then wait** until the progress bar has disappeared and your new credit is shown.

Consider writing down the number of your MensaCard. If you lose it, the canteen team will need this number to secure the credit left.

Enjoy your meal!

Allergens are shown as numbers on the menu screens. Complete allergen lists are provided on some of the pillars in the canteen.

As a guest, you pay the **third price category** shown on the menu screens.

You pay separately for **every other side dish** you take: Eating one single grain of rice and one piece of carrot costs more than a 3D normal distribution made from mashed potatoes covering your entire plate...

At the end of the conference...

Insert your MensaCard into a special vending machine next to the exit ("Gastkartenautomat") to get back any remaining money.

Otherwise, please **give back your MensaCard** at the registration desk.
